




To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements:






Which of the following do you consider to be the most important strategic partners for your country? Pick max. 2.







Those who believe the following countries present a **security threat** to **Czechia**




Those who believe that **Russia** presents a security threat to their country




Those who believe that **China** presents a security threat to Czechia




Do you personally think any of the following groups, countries or **ideas** threaten your identity and values?

When thinking about the potential impact of **Artificial Intelligence** on your life or the lives of next generation, to what extent do you feel **optimistic or pessimistic**?








Who is primarily responsible for the war in Ukraine?










To what extent are you overall satisfied with how democracy works in your country?




