



Funding and Partners

- GLOBSEC's independent and non-partisan status is maintained through its transparent and projectbased funding.
- The funding for GLOBSEC comes from a number of sources such as endowment, flagship conferences, memberships as well as from grants, projects and our initiatives.
- None of our donors provide more than 10% of our financial resources.
- In 2023 corporate partners represented 42% of the total income. Institutions (including governments) contributed 38%, and approximately 20% of the total income came from foundations and NGOs.


